Dear Sue, Ron, and Board Members:

The Beverly Beach Improvement Club's Small Water System Management Program (SWSMP), received in this office on July 13, 2007, with subsequent submittals received on December 18, 2007, February 6, 2008, and February 15, 2008, has been reviewed and in accordance with the provisions of WAC 246-290-105, is hereby APPROVED.

The SWSMP demonstrates the Beverly Beach Improvement Club Water System has the design capacity to support **176 equivalent residential units**. Based upon the information submitted by your engineer, Douglas J. Lane, P.E, in Element 8 of the water system plan, full build out of residential lots in your service area will be less than the original 305 platted lots within Division 1 and 2. Our records indicate there are currently 115 existing residential connections.

Approval of this plan is valid as it relates to current standards outlined in Chapter 246-290 WAC, revised July 2004, Chapter 246-293 WAC, revised September 1997, Chapter 70.116 RCW, the Island County Coordinated Water System Plan (CWSP), and the requirements of the Municipal Water Law (SESSHB 1338), effective September 9, 2003, and is subject to the qualifications herein. Future revisions in the rules and statutes may be more stringent and require facility modification or corrective action.

Submittal of your plan includes an internal determination of local government consistency. This determination also includes documentation of the steps taken to communicate with the following entity: Island County Planning and Development, regarding local government consistency. This SWSMP meets local government consistency requirements for SWSMP approval pursuant to RCW 90.03.386, RCW 43.20.



This approval does not provide any guarantee and should not be considered to provide any guarantee concerning legal use of water or subsequent water rights decisions by the Department of Ecology. A copy of this document was sent to Ecology on July 17, 2007. Ecology had no objections. DOH is making this approval based upon the water system's water right analysis and the limit of the existing service area.

DOH also has not received any indication from Ecology that the small water system management program is not inconsistent with the watershed plan approved on June 20, 2005 by the Board of Island County Commissioners.
